Please Note : Stamford is an exceptionally beautiful town with many buildings from the Middle Ages, and the 18th Century. However, this means that the streets are narrow. There is no parking immediately ant the venue and on-street parking is very limited. There are a number of car parks within 15 minutes walk of the venue.

We encourage participants to come by train. Stamford has direct hourly connections from Stanstead, Cambridge Ely, Norwich, Oakham, Melton Mowbray, Leicester, Nuneaton and Birmingham. It is also accessible via the East Coast Main Line, with a simple change at Peterborough.

We will provide a bookable minibus pick up where possible for those with mobility difficulties.
